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**The Sorrowful Mysteries  
of the Rosary**

**1. The Agony in the Garden**

- ◆ As God is always present with us, He asks us to be present with Him. In his final hours, as Jesus was in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane, He asked His disciples to stand watch with Him, but they could not. Can we?

**2. The Scourging at the Pillar**

- ◆ The soldiers took delight in scourging the Lord, in whipping him, tearing the flesh on his back with such brutality. How would their actions have been different if they had truly known they were in the presence of God, that it is the Son of God whom they were treating so cruelly?

**3. The Crowning with Thorns**

- ◆ After the soldiers had scourged the Lord, they mocked Him as they impaled his head with sharp thorns formed in the shape of a crown. In the presence of the Son of God, King of the Universe, they scornfully called out, "Hail, king of the Jews".

**4. The Carrying of the Cross**

- ◆ Surrounded by a jeering crowd, how alone must Christ have felt as He was forced to carry the means of His execution through the streets. Today, some 2,000 years later, He is present with us to help us carry our every burden.

**5. The Crucifixion and Death of the Lord**

- ◆ After hours of agony, the Son of God took His last breath. In all human history, no greater sacrifice has ever been made. In dying He conquered death, that we may live in His presence forevermore.



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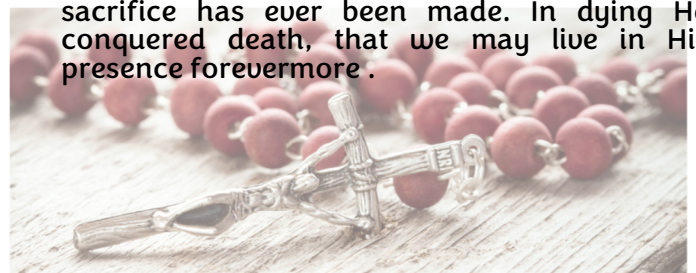
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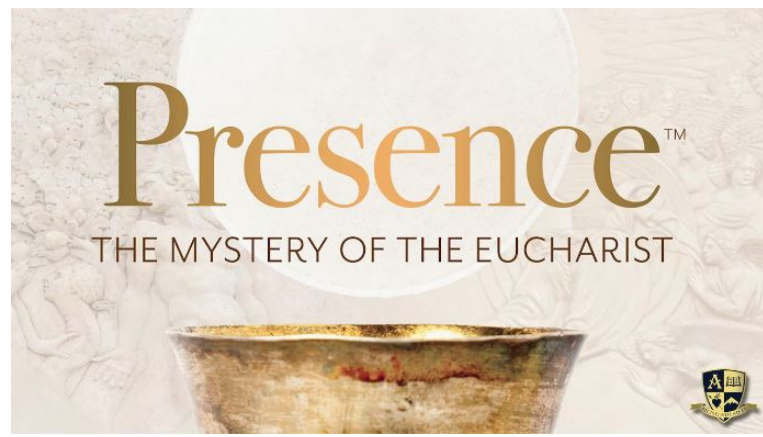
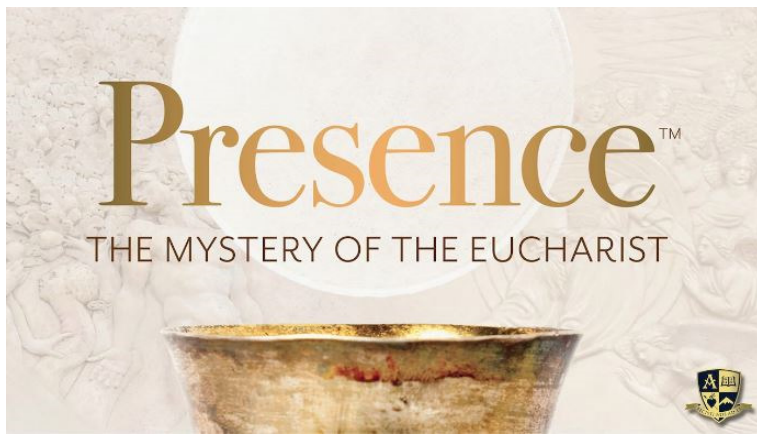
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**Questions for Reflection**
