Month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: Part 2

n June 16, 1675, Jesus told Sr. Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honored His Sacred Heart. He also gave Sr. Margaret Mary 12 promises made to all who venerate and promote the devotion of the Sacred Heart. He said: "I ask of you that the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi be set apart for a special feast to honor my heart, by receiving Communion on that day, and making reparation to it by a solemn act, in order to make amends for the indignities which it has received during the time it has been exposed on the altars. I promise you that my heart shall expand itself to shed in abundance the influence of its divine love upon those who shall thus honor it, and cause it to be honored."

Sr. Margaret Mary died in 1690 and was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 13, 1920.

Devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus are numerous. Some have been explicitly approved and frequently recommended by the Apostolic See. These are: Personal Consecration, Family Consecration, The Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart, and The Practice of the First Fridays. The pious practice of the first Fridays of the month was derived from the "great promises" made by Jesus to St. Margaret Mary. Here are the 12 promises that Jesus made to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque for those who practice the devotion to His most Sacred Heart:

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2. I will give peace to their families.
- 3. I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4. I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- 5. I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners shall find in my heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.

- 8. Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless those places wherein the image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- 10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my heart.
- 12. In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the first Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

In 1856, Pope Pius IX designated the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart for the universal Church. Ever since, the month of June has been devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and His immense love for us all. The feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a solemnity, the highest-ranking feast in the liturgical calendar, although it is not a holy day of obligation. This feast is the antidote to some of the ills of the society we live it.

At this moment in our world, torn by so much violence and suffering, we need to let our own hearts be filled with the love of the Sacred Heart, so that the flames of God's love reach the world through us. So let us ask for two graces this month: first, the grace to be convinced of God's love for each one of us personally, manifested in the Sacred Heart of Jesus; second, for the grace to show that love to all those around us, to love others as Jesus has loved us.


