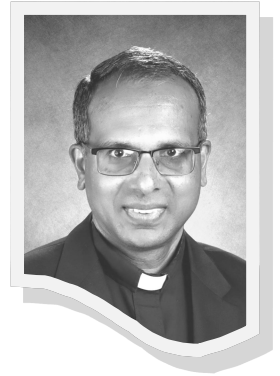

From the Pastor



Rebuild My Church, Phase II

We are now ready to kick off the campaign for Phase II of the Renovation of the Historic Church—*Rebuild My Church*. This will complete the renovation that we began a year ago, the campaign for which started two years prior to that.

The Phase II is estimated to cost about \$1.3 million, and we are hoping that we will come across no surprises.

St. Francis of Assisi heard the Lord's call as he knelt underneath a large wooden crucifix in San Damiano: "Francis! Francis! Go and repair my house which, as you can see, is falling into ruins!"

Taking that command very literally, Francis set about physically rebuilding the little church—stone by stone. He did the same with other abandoned churches in the area, having gone about begging for help to complete his work. Only later did he understand the call in a broader sense.

Today, I write to ask your help to complete the repair of the Lord's house that we began a year ago in the way St. Francis understood first—a physical building—the Historic Church.

We began the campaign for Phase I with "seed money" of \$500,000 of which \$300,000 came from the Historic Church Maintenance Fund, and the Finance Committee committing \$200,000 from the Capital Repairs and Maintenance account. To lock in the pricing of Phase II, and to sign the contract, the Finance Council has again committed another \$150,000 from the Capital Repairs and Maintenance account.

The Phase II project has been approved by the Bishop, and the contract has been signed—with the down payment of \$150,000—thanks to our Blessed Mother through whose intercession the money we lost to fraud was restored. The work is expected to begin the first week of January 2025.

Phase II of the project will consist of refinishing the pews, the flooring, the lighting, the walls, the ceiling, the Stations of the Cross, the confessionals, the entry way, and the choir loft. This next phase of the renovation will extend from the sanctuary to the rest of the church, thus tying everything together

nicely. With this phase, *you, the Church* (the people of God), will literally feel the difference wherever you choose to sit.

We have several items available for your sponsorship, such as the Stations of the Cross, the pews, the floor medallions, the organ, the church bell, and the confessionals.

We had several "open houses" toward the end of the Phase I Renovation, and all who came in were astonished at the marvelous work already done and, therefore, it is not surprising that 94 percent of those who responded to the survey are in support of proceeding with Phase II to complete the renovation. The City of Bend chose our project for its Annual Historic Preservation Month.

If you have not already, you will be receiving information in the mail about *Rebuild My Church—Phase II*, along with a pledge card. If you do not receive the packet this week, we do have extra copies in the narthex of both churches. Please read the information carefully, pray, and respond as generously as you can.

If you or someone you know can make a larger gift, there are several sponsorship opportunities available as noted above. I am grateful for any gift you can make toward the Phase II Renovation.

Finally, I'd like to close with a paragraph from a recent article in the *National Catholic Register* by Timothy O'Donnell, President of Chistendom College in Front Royal, Virginia:

One of the greatest glories of the Middle Ages was the advent of Gothic architecture. With high pointed arches and stained-glass windows that flooded cathedrals with ethereal light, this architectural style lifted the heart and mind upwards towards contemplation of God. Now, in an era that can truly be described as another Dark Ages, where truth is stifled and Christ is marginalized, a return to beautiful architecture that raises one's eyes and soul to God is not just important, but also necessary.

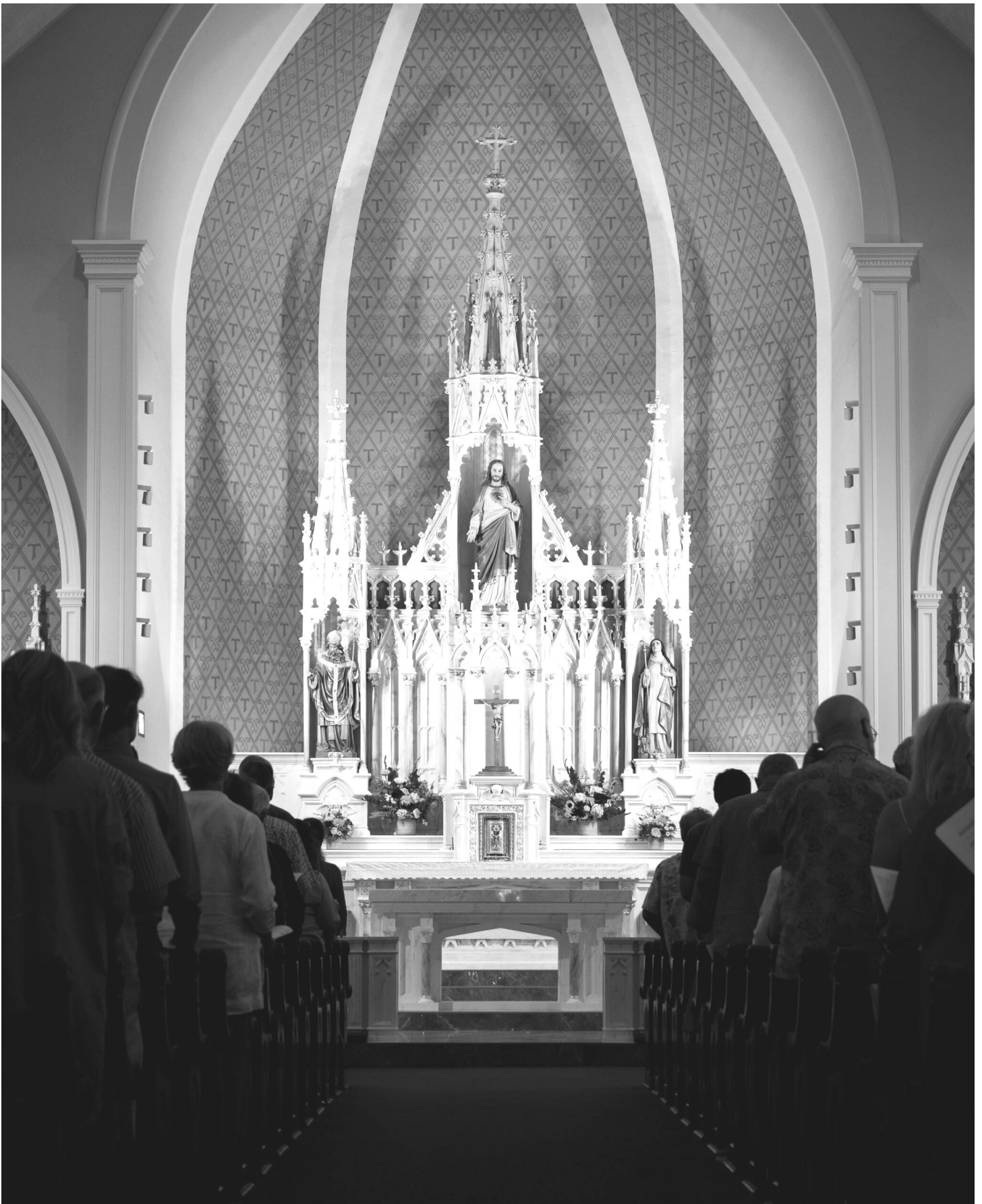


